To install the floor the Ryebrook team first had to key the concrete slab with shot-blasting and make good where necessary. The Ryetech coating was then laid to a thickness of 0.5mm throughout the 700m² factory, including the shop floor offices, toilets and corridors. "The working environment is certainly made more attractive with the colourful resin floor and this has helped encourage a positive mindset amongst our employees," observes David Ross.
