

The new Jenkins & Pain accident repair workshop at White Cliffs Business Park near Dover benefits from a durable resin floor, supplied and installed by Ryebrook Resins Ltd. Although practicality was top priority for Managing Director, David Jenkinson, aesthetics was also an important consideration. Creating a high-impact, visual solution the solvent-free epoxy floor coating, Ryetech was laid as a light grey in the aisles and a contrasting ice blue for the work bays, with a clear white line distinguishing the two areas.



Any car repair centre floor is obviously liable to considerable wear and tear from tools, machinery as well as oil spillages etc. Maintaining a safe and professional workshop under these conditions is made easier with a resin floor. Ryebrook has over 30 years of specialist knowledge and experience in the formulation and application of seamless floor and wall coatings ideally suited to car workshops and showrooms. Although Ryetech can be applied to existing concrete surfaces, the 850 m² Jenkins & Pain workshop floor was in fact a brand new concrete slab. After shot blasting and vacuuming the floor, this high build coating was laid to a thickness of 0.5mm, giving the required level of loading and impact resistance for the circumstances, as well as providing chemical and slip-resistance.
